

What Would Happen If We Returned To Worship

1. We worship as a result of our relationship with God. Our relationship with God leads us to worship Him. Describe your experience before, during and after worship. How much do you identify with Ps 122:1? What can we do to nurture our worship of God?

2. Read Heb 10:25. Many of us do not edify each other in our speech, much less encourage one another to worship. Others have simply stopped attending worship altogether. This is contrary to God’s desire for a deepening relationship with us. God reveals Himself to His people, and there is so much He would reveal if we would return to Him. It is God’s ultimate desire that none should be lost or ruined by sin.
 - What should our attitudes and actions during worship be as worshippers who love God and one another ?

- Read Ezekiel 18: 30 -32. How does this impact our hearts as we think of God’s great compassion for us? How could deep love be communicated in worship?

3. Read Isaiah 6:1-8. How does Isaiah’s return to worship transform him?

- Often God waits to call us to be witnesses to His Love and purpose before a watching world. As we return to true worship, we will encounter God fully and our response will be “Here am I. Send me.” What do we believe God could do to and through a church that returns to a full and true relationship with God in worship and obedience?

- Personal Reflection : As I desire to worship God fully in Spirit and in Truth, I commit this week to :

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1. Read Acts 13.1-3.

- Describe the outcome of the worship?

- How many who heard God speak are able to predict that millions of believers and churches would result from the worship service where they set apart Barnabas and Saul(Paul) for His work? Explain

- God equipped, inspired and commissioned us serve Him in the setting of a worship gathering. Knowing this, how should we look at worship services? See also Acts 2:4

2. A self-centred church is not a worshipping church. How does an “on-mission” church contrasts with the church at Laodicea (Rev 3: 24-17). How does worship turn our hearts towards mission work?

3. If we are truly being obedient to God in worship, in what ways could we demonstrate our repentant commitment to godly, humble, awestruck, praising, prayerful worship? Discuss.

4. Personal Reflection - The most important lesson I have learned about worship and which I commit to act upon is :
