Church Camp '09: Guidelines for Registration & Rooming

All camp participants are encouraged to confirm their bookings as soon as possible to secure their accommodation and facilitate the planning and administration of the camp programme and logistics. We appreciate your co-operation and understanding in helping to make the Church Camp 2009 an edifying and enjoyable one.

1. The following 2009 camp fees apply to all members, visitors and church workers.

Adults (Working)	\$250
Adults (Non-working)	\$170
Youth/House Helpers	\$170
Child (4 to 11 years)	\$80
Child (with extra bed)	\$150
Single Room	\$440

2. Please note the following for registration and payment:

- a. Registration will be conducted from Jan – Apr 2009. Please have ready, Date of Birth and Passport Number (including Date of Issue and Date of Expiry). Note that 6 months' passport validity is required for travel to Malaysia.
- b. Full payment is required by end Apr 2009.
- c. Members who require financial assistance may approach any of the Registration Committee members.
- d. Accommodation w before end Feb 2009.
- e. Registrations after end Apr 2009 will be accepted on a case-by-case basis, and accommodation is not guaranteed as hotel rooms are limited.
- f. Single rooms (without church subsidies) are available but are limited and based on a case-by-case basis.

- g. Cancellations before end Apr 2009 will receive a full refund of the fees, but any cancellation thereafter will not be entitled to a refund as payment would have been made to the hotel.

3. Please note the following for rooming:

- a. Rooming will be on a minimum twin-sharing basis for adults.
- b. Preference will be given to members who have indicated their preferred roommate, based on a mutual agreement between the parties.
- c. Allocation will be done at the discretion of the committee if preference for a roommate is not indicated.
- d. Children aged 11 years old and below will be required to room with at least 2 adults.
- e. Youths may be required to share rooms on a triple-sharing basis; the designated youth leader will handle the arrangements for youth rooming.
- g. Roommates may not be changed without the prior knowledge and consent of the committee. This is crucial for proper accounting and tracking of each participant during the camp.

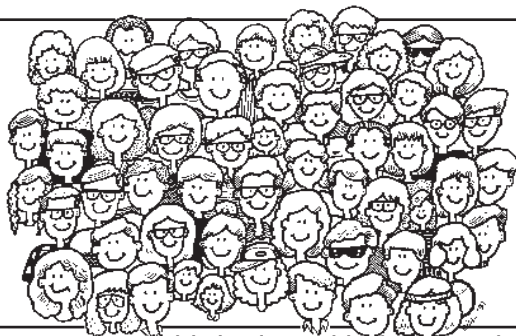
