SIBI's OBS (Open Bible Study) is in full swing - bring a friend to study with brother Charles Cook on the book of Romans at 10am.

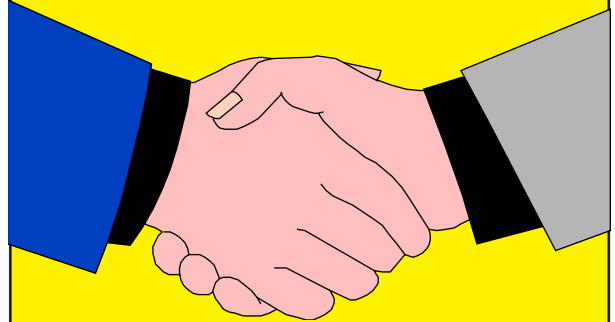
In the evening, SPC (School of Practical Christianity) takes off at 7:30pm with a new series on the parables of Jesus by brother Cher Yam.
