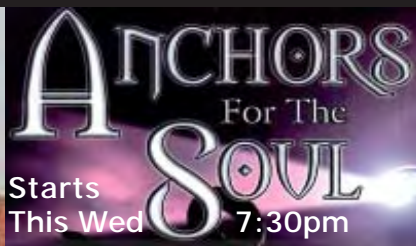

Suggestions for Congregational Singing

While all should sing with the spirit and understanding, when we are gathered together, there is much we can do to improve our congregational singing:

1. If you cannot hear the person next you singing, you are singing too loud.
2. Attempt to sing your part if possible. Join the monthly a cappella singing to learn how.
3. Brother Daniel has an excellent singing class which he conducts a few times each year. Register with him for the next class.

Songleaders, you can help by allowing the congregation to sing and not drowning the congregational singing by leading too loud. If you cannot hear the congregation sing, you are singing too loudly.
