Next Month

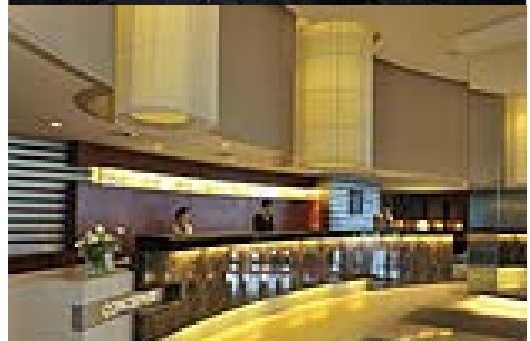
Each year, PP's annual June camp grows larger and better. Also, because of rooms not being available near the event, we are having to turn away more and more campers.

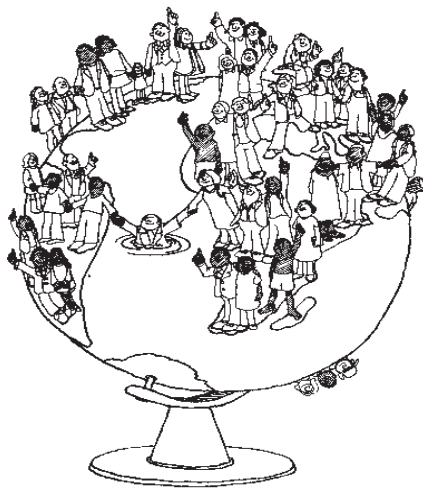

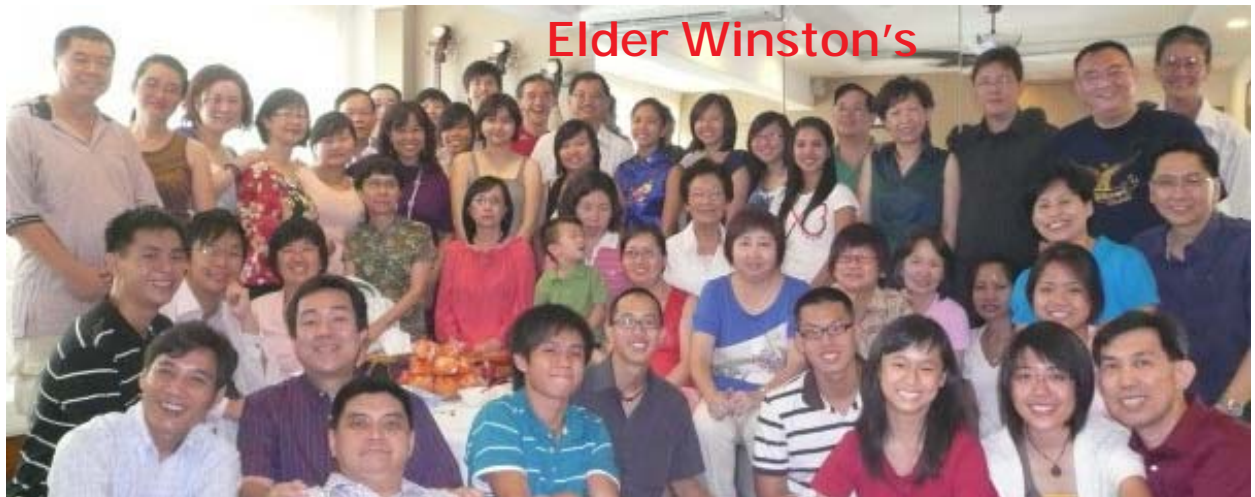
